Drilling:

When drilling simply place the seed in the small seed box of your drill. If your drill does not have a small seed box, take care to make sure to not plant the seed too deep. One trick that works is to broadcast the pollinator mix first and then drill your grasses over the top. The action of the tractor and the drill will then press the seed into the soil.

Broadcasting:

Work the ground to a firm seed bed. You should be able to bounce a basketball or soccer ball on it and see reasonable bounce back. Broadcast the grasses and pollinator mix evenly over the ground and follow by running a light drag over the field. This can be done in small pastures by dragging a small section of chain-link fence or even a pallet. The goal is to lightly cover the seed with soil. For best results you will want to follow this step by running a roller over the ground. This will firmly push the seed into the soil.
